

Interministerial Regulations 2022

Which will take place at the "Country Hall of Liège" on 5 and 6 November 2022

Art 1 The price of the pitch (2.20 X 0.70 m) is set at € 180 VAT. (149 € H.VAT) It is reduced to 150 € VAT. (124 € excl. VAT) if paid before 15 October.

For foreign exhibitors from the European Community, the price per table is htVA on the condition that the exhibitor justifies his right to the application of the VAT reverse charge regime, The right to the application of this regime must be proved, from the moment of registration, by providing the certificate of validity of the VAT number to be obtained exclusively on the VIES website of the European Community: http://ec.europa.eu/taxation_customs/vies/vatRequest.html

The application to participate must be sent by post or email before September ^{1st}

Art 2 INTERMINERAL is above all a mineralogical and paleontological stock exchange exhibition. Jewelry is tolerated (MAX a quarter of the stand area.)

Art 3 Any cancellation of reservation must be reported by registered letter before October 15, in order to benefit from the reimbursement of registration fees. After this date no refund will be made, except in major cases.

Art 4 The room will be accessible to exhibitors:

Friday from 12.00 to 19.00 h, Saturday from 08.00 h and Sunday from 8.30 h.

The scholarship will be open to the public from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday..

The room must be vacated in the evening before 20.00 h (activation of the alarm)

Art 5 The space granted is 2.20 x 0.70 m per table to exhibit the material

Lateral overtaking is not allowed. The frontal may not exceed 1 m and must respect the general alignment of the façade, and, not be a gene for the neighborhood.

Intermediate table installation is not allowed. Prohibition of putting equipment in sale outside the tables.

The exhibitor must not obstruct the passages, nor modify the facilities (without authorization),

The exposed material is under his full responsibility, as well as any damage he may have caused. furniture or any other installation. Garbage bags will be at their disposal for waste disposal.

Art 6 The decoration of the stands is under the responsibility of the exhibitor and complies with the legislation

Belgian (electricity). The use of covering sheets must be flame retardant. The stands are equipped with electrical outlets, the power is limited to 300W / meter of table, the use of modern lighting (LEDs) is highly recommended.

Art 7 The name and origin of the mineral or fossil on display must be specified. Prices must be displayed in euros.

Art 8 Cave concretions, pines, paintings on stones, synthetic or colored minerals, fossils unnatural, contemporary insects and butterflies are not admitted to the scholarship. Copies and exhibits restored must be reported as such. Archaeological pieces are tolerated.

Art 9 The organizers have the right to control the goods on display and to demand the removal Immediate objects that are in contradiction with the spirit of the manifestation.

Art 10 The organizers decline all responsibility in the event of thefts and incidents that may occur during the scholarship.

The building is under alarm and controlled. It will be closed from 20:00 to 08:00 for security reasons

Art 11 The exhibitor must comply with the legislation on trade, customs, etc.... Exhibitors undertake to comply with these rules.

Art 12 The organizers reserve the right to rule on any case not provided for in these rules.

Art 13 Any offender who does not respect the rules will be automatically excluded for scholarships Subsequent.
